We have two kind of gerunds:

➔ As subject

➔ As object

First of all the base form for the gerund.

V + ing

👉 Gerund as subject:

Its come at the beginning of the sentence and it always singular, use a third person.

E.g.: sleeping early is good for your body.

👉 Gerund as object:

It's come after the verb

E.g.: she began learning French.

We often use go with gerund to describe activities, and we can use it in present or past tens.

E.g.: I went swimming for 2 hours.
