<b>Stops</b>	Stopping of the air stream then letting it go abruptly	[p] [k] [t]	[b] [d] [g]
<b>Fricatives</b>	Almost blocking the air stream and having the air push through the very narrow opening .as the air is pushed through	[f] [θ] [s] [ʃ] [h]	[v] [ð] [z] [ʒ]
<b>Affricates</b>	Combine a brief stopping of the air stream with an obstructed release which causes some friction	[tʃ]	[dʒ]
<b>Nasals</b>	The velum is lowered and the air stream is allowed to flow out through the nose		[m] [n] [ŋ]
<b>Liquids</b>	The air stream flow around the sides of the tongue as the tip of the tongue makes contact with the middle of the alveolar		[l]
	The tongue tip raised and curled back near the alveolar ridge		[r]
<b>glides</b>	The tongue in gliding from the position of vowel		[w] [j]
