Gestures → are mostly used while speaking

Signs → like speech and instead of speaking

Context → seem to be a reflection of the meaning of what is said

Deictics → pointing to things or people while talking

Beats → short quick movements of the hand or fingers.

alternate sign language → system of hand signals developed by speakers for limited communication.

Primary sign language → the first language of a group of people who do not use a spoken language with each other.
