the role of the use of computers in English language teaching to academic achievement among students in the High school-Khafji

Introduction

Computer Considered one of the greatest inventions of this age. So many uses and all walks of life. In the educational field has emerged using computers dramatically and sophisticated as many of its uses in the development of the educational process and of these uses what appears in the programs of training and simulation and self-learning.

It also conducted numerous studies and scientific research confirming the effectiveness of the application of computer in modern educational trends based on self-learning, learning to learn, and to increase the responsibility of the individual for learning (Alshdefat, 2011, p. 779).

Research Problem:

- 3. There are no difference Of statistical significance level (0.05) in average academic achievement for students in English depending on the different class.

- 2. use of computers has proven the importance of raising the level of academic achievement among students.
- 3. provide useful information about principals using computers as a modern method in teaching.

Research Methodology:

The study used experimental method by dividing the sample into two groups one pilot is taught English by computer, And the other officer is taught in the traditional manner, and at the end of the semester being standardized test for both groups, and through the test results is determined by the level of academic achievement for the two groups and the results are compared with each other and identify differences in level.

Study Population:

All second and third graders of secondary general education schools in the city of Al Khafji.

Study Sample

The sample is chosen in a cluster by selecting the number of rows randomly from each school in each school one class group officer and another class of the experimental group, and apply the full study students selected classes.
