Body paint or face paint is used mostly by men in pre-literate societies in order to ward off disease. It is a form of magic protection against the dangers of the village, where men have to go for the hunt or for war. When it is used as warpaint, it frighten the enemy, distinguish members of one's own group from the enemy, or sense of identity, of belonging to the group. Women have less need of body or they usually stay in the safety of the village.
