2-The calendar of the impact of technology on student achievement is a complex process.

3-Changes in the classroom with other educational factors change as research indicates that the same educational model (for example, using interactive video videos vs or vs education direct) impact on student achievement as long as technology education commensurate with the content, and that all participants have access to the type of technology user himself. Evidences have shown that students who conduct their learning online are better than students who work in traditional settings for the learning of a second language, in terms of their levels of anxiety and their need for gap awareness in their language skills” (Pichette, 2009, p77). “Studies have also shown that the use of technologies in teaching languages have an increased advantages in the development of grammar, vocabulary, reading, writing, pronunciation, listening, and speaking skills” (Levy, 2009, p93).
