## Aphasias

- 1-is language impairment linked to a brain lesion

## Broca's aphasia

- 1-noun-fluent and halting ,effortful speech
- 2-located in the frontal lobe of the hemisphere of the brain
- 3-(the speech associated )has been characterized as (agrammatic)
- 4-Content words (lacking syntactic and morphological structure

## Wernicke's aphasia

- 1-(fluent meaningless strings)
- 2-area located in temporal lobe of the hemisphere of the brain
- 3-has stretches of grammatically organized clauses and phrases

## Language lateralization
