There are different ideas about shopping in the future. Some people say "Everybody is going to shop online, from home. There won't be any more real stores or shopping malls." But other people have a different picture of the future. They say, "There will be still shopping malls. In the future, many people will work at home, alone, on their computers. They'll want to go out to stores for their shopping. They'll want to socialize—be with other people." Maybe they're right.
