



If you suffer from shyness, you are not alone, for shyness is a universal phenomenon. According to recent research, "close to 50 percent of the general population report that they currently experience some degrees of shyness in their lives. In addition, close to 80 percent of people report that having felt shy at some point in their lives". As shyness is so prevalent in the world, it is not surprising that social scientists are learning more about its causes. They have found that shyness in an individual can result from both biological and environmental factors.

Recent researches reveals that some individuals are genetically predisposed to shyness. in other words, some people are born shy. Researchers say that between 15 and 20 percent of newborn babies show signs of shyness: they are quieter and more vigilant.

The first environmental cause of shyness may be a child's home and family life. Children who grew up with a difficult relationship with parents or a dominating older sibling are more likely to be inhibited in social interactions. Another factor is fewer and fewer relatives living nearby.

While being shy has some negative consequences, it has positive aspects, too. For one thing, it has been mentioned that shy people are good listeners. Furthermore, a university professor writing about his own shyness says, "Because of their tendency toward self-criticism, shy people are often high achievers, and not just in solitary activities like research and writing. Perhaps even more than the toward independent achievement, shy people long to make
