It has been approved by the school administration, which retains the name of a secret and has the approval of the mothers in the answer to the questionnaire and to keep their name's secret.

Limitation of the Research:

My search was in the Taif city in a primary school for girls. I had a meeting with 15 mothers of the students who they saw that YouTube lessons had a positive effect on their children in English language acquisition, while there were other mothers saw that it had a negative impact on their children. If my research included students of boys and girls possibly, the result will be better and more positive. Also if the number of mothers of students expanded and raised the number to 100, the result would be better.

Expected results:

I expect that about 90% of moms agree that their children use modern technology and educational YouTube channels to acquire the English language. They find useful and had a positive impact. But when we distributed an electronic questionnaire, we find this result; 58% believed that modern technology is good, 36% found it helpful and 6% deemed injurious. However, there were 26% agreed to learn the English language through YouTube, 66% agreed with that. On the other hand, there were 6% rejected this type of education. There were 84% believe that this type of education affects positively on their children, while 12% believed that it affects negatively.

Moreover, after we have an inventory of mothers of students in the elementary school questionnaire turned out that 33% believed that modern technology is good while 60% found it helpful and 7% deemed injurious. In fact, there were 7% approved of the acquisition of the English language through educational channel's YouTube while 87% disagreed but limit 6% rejected this type of education.

In addition, 93% believed that this type of education affects positively on their children, while 7% believed it affects negatively. Finally, we went back to Twitter and Alhastag in the proportion of 95% agreed with English language teaching via YouTube while 5% rejected it.
